



What is a FarmRaiser?

FarmRaiser is a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) subscription program of Sun Produce Cooperative (SPC) that provides easy access to healthy food options and supports place-based wellness strategies. It offers a fundraising component for your school or business while supporting local farmers.

Tailored For Your Group

Prices of the bags and length of sessions can be tailored to suit your group, but typically run in 3- to 8-week sessions at a cost of \$11-\$25 a bag. Participants receive bags of locally grown, fresh farm items each week. Bags can include a selection of vegetables, fruits, herbs, eggs, honey, beans, flowers and more. Produce items vary according to which crops are ready for harvesting during a given week.

Farm Stand Options

Add extra items each week and offer them for sale separately from the bags to subscribers or folks who haven't signed up.

How do I set up a FarmRaiser Program with Sun Produce Co-op?

- Identify who will lead the program. (e.g. clubs, parents, staff, volunteers)
- Plan the number of weeks in your FarmRaiser session and the time and location for distribution.
- · Place weekly produce orders.
- Pick bag sizes and decide how they will be packed. SPC can pack for a fee, or raise money by engaging volunteers in packing.
- Provide a logo for the website where customers
- Recruit customers to join the FarmRaiser!

What is the Fundraising Option?

If your organization chooses to pack the bags each week, 10% of the sale of each bag will go back to the host organization as a healthful way to raise funds!
