SNAP & Double UP

SNAP / EBT (formerly food stamps) helps people stretch their food dollars, increasing access to and affordability of healthy foods while supporting expanded sales for farmers! SNAP benefits are available YEAR-ROUND to eligible households and individuals. A federal program administered in our state by the Arizona Department of Economic Security (DES), SNAP benefits are provided on an electronic benefit card that is used like an ATM or debit card.

Sun Produce Co-op gladly accepts SNAP / EBT as a form of payment at two of its Farm Raiser sites: Concordia Charter School and Clark Park Community Garden and is actively seeking more sites to work with. In addition, Sun Produce Co-op partners with Double Up Food Bucks Arizona – <u>https://www.doubleupaz.org</u> – a program of Pinnacle Prevention. Double Up provides a price-match for customers paying for their farm bag programs at with their SNAP / EBT cards. The match program is like getting half off the price of the Bag.
